Rotary Shoebox Workshop

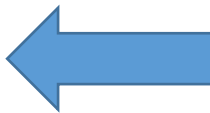
Our shoebox workshop is taking place next Wednesday 7th November. Every child will be given the opportunity to fill a shoebox whilst working in pairs.
